The Russian Postal Savings Stamps

(Note: The following is translated by the writer from the Russian publication MAPKN ("Stamps") No. 17, dated 15 May 1897. It is translated literally to allow the feel of the Imperial Russian bureaucracy at its best. It is believed that this item has not appeared in western philatelic circles, nor, possibly, even in Russian literature of this century. If I err, please forgive. As recently as in the July 1974 issue of the British Journal of Russian Philately, Dr. R. J. Ceresa, one of the foremost students of Russian philately, who reads and speaks Russian, in his article on Postal Savings and Control Stamps, says: "As far as is known, these stamps were used ONLY fiscally in connection with the Postal Savings Bank established sometime in the 19th century. The earliest seen usage of the large format higher values is with the manuscript date of 4 March 1896". Dr. Ceresa also asks if any reader knows if these Savings Bank Books were kept at the post office where the account was held, or whether the depositor kept his own book and could deposit funds via the stamp cards at any post office? The translated article below states: The Savings stamps booklets are kept by the depositors.



Either this cancellation was used by a railway company or it was imitated. Enclosed is an illustration of their perfins from a catalog published by the Perfins Society. The perfins is common.

I also have some additional denominations of the Danish revenues that were shown in the September, 1974, and January, 1975, issues of the AR. They are:



Known denominations are: 1 (redbrown), 2 (orange), 5 (green), 10 (red), 25 (blue), 50 (greyish violet) and 1 Korona (olivebrown). Previous inquiries in English and Swedish publications have only brought knowledge of additional values. I have duplicates of the 5 (ore) that I would like to trade for a 2, 10, 25 or any denomination not listed above.

The President's Page

FIRST THE GOOD NEWS....

Steps for incorporation of the ARA as a non-profit organization by our Attorney Zach Carney have been completed; the Association is duly registered in Tennessee as such, and we are now the ARA, Inc. Effective date was 1 January, 1977, and the Charter of Incorporation now resides in the Secretary's files. (A follow-on effort is in process to obtain federal recognition as a tax-exempt organization...more to follow when completed.)

THEN THE BAD....

After a careful study of a) our rising operating costs, and b) our treasury reserves, and appropriate extrapolation, despite our efforts to maintain dues at their prior level, it has been determined that we cannot continue to provide the services we do and stay in the black. Therefore, with approval of the Board, we are forced to raise the dues effective immediately....HOLD ON.....THOSE WHO HAVE PAID THEIR 1977 DUES WILL NOT BE IMPACTED. They will see the effect only when the next dues notices appear for October. But those of you who have blank membership applications on hand are requested to mark them up with the revised rates before you hand or send out any more:

Regular membership changes from \$4 to \$6 a year, while Contributing membership increases from \$6 minimum to \$9 minimum. Additionally, change the rate for overseas airmail service from \$5 to \$10. (The older rate was carried as a gesture of good will, since the postal increase here last year immediately overran our costs...time to catch up).

For those who may object: 1) these dues are less than those of other philatelic organizations who provide fewer services; 2) consider those services (with more to come) and ponder whether they are worth the added cost; finally, 3) amortized over 10 journals a year the total increase is 20c per issue. These steps would not have been taken unless they were absolutely necessary, and your cooperation will be appreciated.

ACCORDINGLY....

You will find herein a membership application for your use. If EACH recipient uses same to recruit one other new member, the membership will DOUBLE, right now, and the funding problem be alleviated over the short haul. Your assistance is required. If this move is successful, we may even see thicker journals (we have the backlog) and other advantages. Help us?

BALONEY

On the (alas) subject of UNSOLICITED APPROVALS, we thought we had shortly ago provided the final word; apparently not. Since then, and recently, some correspondence was seen wherein it was stated that sending them out was MANDATORY for business. Again, BALONEY. One more time: federal law dictates that the sender MUST include a statement that the material may be considered as a GIFT, and that the recipient NEED NOT PAY. Last time, we offered no advice, but in view of the absurdity of the MANDATORY statement.....IF you receive unordered merchandise of any nature, you have several options:

1. If the required (by law) words do not appear, immediately turn the material over to the postal authorities, advising them of the non-adherence to the law; or
2. Either way, give yourself a treat and keep them; YOU ARE NOT OBLIGATED TO PAY; or
3. Either way, if the material is unwanted, throw it away; especially recommended in the event return postage is not included.

In any case, write the sender a letter DEMANDING that no further material be sent, keep a copy, and mail the original certified, return receipt requested.

If there is harassment of any nature on the matter, repro such correspondence and get copies to your attorney AND the postal authorities, together with a copy of your "cease and desist" letter. Let them take it from there. This is particularly true in the case where the material never arrived, and you are being threatened. Make the practice so unprofitable that its perpetrators will soon find it less than MANDATORY. If further advice is required, write to this office.

(SRS: Recommend you copy in the Newsletter; some of your members may find themselves in this situation and be unaware of their legal rights. APS members please note....if the sender is also an APS member, register a complaint with them, copying them on all correspondence. They won't fool around with it over-long. The APS is also welcome to copy, to advise the membership of the options.)

ISLAND TRADER

THE PHILIPPINE ISLANDS: Current Revenues

Terry Hines, ARA

A friend recently returned from a trip to the Philippines, and brought back with him several revenue stamps. As almost all of these were not listed in Warren's (1967) catalog, my curiosity was aroused and I set out to obtain information on the revenues currently in use in the Islands.

Perhaps the most interesting set now in use is the set of Science stamps. These are documentary stamps and funds from their sale goes to the National Science Development Board to fund scientific research. All documents subject to the regular documentary tax are also subject to the payment of this additional tax, which rate is generally 100 percent of the regular documentary tax rate. The use of these stamps began on 1 January, 1969 under the provisions of Republic Act No. 5448. Two different designs are used, one for the centavo issues and the other for the peso denominations.

1969

Science allegories, 24x37½ mm (c denoms), 38x25 mm (P denoms); rouletted, no gum, paper with silk fibers, unwmkd. Figure 1 (c values), Figure 2 (P values).






Figure 4: The 100R stamp is printed with dark brown ink and the background is iridescent. In the central part for about one-third of the length of the stamp the color is red but in directions toward both sides it gradually becomes blue.

Regular documentary stamps are also, of course, used. The lower values, at least, are of a new design, different for the centavo (Figure 3) and Peso (Figure 4) values. The 3P stamp I was sent turned out to be a copy of Warren's W1314 (Figure 5). As this was the highest denomination I ordered, I don't know whether the higher values are also of the new design or if the older stamps are still being used. There are 15 values in the series, as follows:

At least up to the 2P value, these are 22x22 mm., rouletted and ungummed, paper with silk fibers, and unwmkd.



Several additions to Warren's listing of the 1963 documentary series can also be made from the stamps my friend supplied, from documents dated in the early 1970's:

Design A (Arms flanked by palm trees), but rouletted:

2c	green
30c	reddish
30c	orange

Design B (Arms flanked by bamboo stems), but rouletted:

5c	red
10c	yellow
50c	orange

Several classes of taxpaid revenues for cigarettes, tobacco and cigars are in use. While no taxpaid are listed by Warren, they must have been around for some time. Two different types of cigarette stamps are in current use. The first type (Figure 6) is printed in the Philippines; all pay the tax on packs of 20 cigarettes, but at different rates:

Arms in center, 39x19½ mm., rouletted, ungummed, silk thread paper, wmkd arms.

30c	blue	(P15 per 1000 cigarettes)
36c	orange	(P18-1000)
40c	purple	(P20-1000)
48c	green	(P24-1000)
54c	yellow	(P27-1000)
80c	black	(P40-1000)



A second set of cigarette stamps is also being used, and these were printed overseas. The actual value at which these stamps are sold is different than the face value as the tax rates were increased under Presidential Decree No. 753 after they were printed. In addition to the basic design, there is a background inscription REPUBLIKA NG PILIPINAS which is extremely faint and will probably not show in the photo. The color of this multiple background inscription is given in parentheses in the listing. All serial numbers are in black.

Type 1 (For packs of 30 cigarettes) Figure 7

Arms in center, 59x19½ mm., rouletted, plain paper, wmkd mult. KRI.

9c green (brown) tax rate P3-1000 cigs. No value under Decree 753

15c blue (orange) P5-1000. No value under PD 753.



Strip stamps are used for chewing tobacco, smoking tobacco and cigars. Chewing tobacco issues are:

Arms upper left of center, 140x29 mm., rouletted unless noted, unguammed, black printing on white silk thread paper, imperf at both sides. Tax rate is 60c per kilogram. Wmkd mult. BIR and arms. Figure 9.

6c (100 grams)
9c (150 grams)
15c (250 grams) perf 12½
30c (500 grams)
45c (750 grams) perf 12½

Smoking tobacco is taxed at a rate of 75c per kilogram. Only two stamps are used, and all details are the same as for the Chewing tobacco issues. Figure 10.

3.75c (50 grams), perf 12½

7.5 c (100 grams), rouletted



Nine different cigar strips are used. Except as noted, all have the seal as shown. Most have the serial numbers in black or purple at the right, and except as noted, appear handstamped. Several of these are rouletted obliquely, presumably as a security measure. A typical issue is shown in Figure 11. The style of the serial numbers varies greatly from value to value.

Cigar strips, 104x30 mm., unguammed, silk thread paper, black printing, wmkd mult. REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES and arms.

Type A. Tax rate P2.30 per 1000 cigars

2.3c (10 cigars), roul., no serial no., oblique roulette
11.5c (50 cigars), perf 12½

Type B. Tax rate P4.60 per 1000

11.5c (25 cigars), roul., oblique roulette
23c (50 cigars), roul., oblique roulette

Type C. Tax rate P7.00 per 1000

3.5c (5 cigars), roul., no seal in center
7c (10 cigars), roul., red printed serial no.
35c (50 cigars), roul., oblique roul., olive paper, no seal
70c (100 cigars), roul., oblique roul.

An older overprinted cigar strip stamp has also been seen. The basic stamp is for 20 cigars at a tax rate of P6.00-1000 and has a face value of 12c. It is rouletted and rouletted obliquely, printed in black on blue paper with a green background design. The inscription reads "PHILIPPINE EXECUTIVE - COMMISSION - INTERNAL REVENUE" indicating that the unoverprinted stamp was issued before Philippine independence in 1946. The stamp is overprinted "VICTORY" in red at the left and the "PEC" inscription has been lined out and replaced with

N.B.: The large format stamps (27x50 mm.) with denominations from 25K to 100R, were issued at first in the 19th century; the small format stamps (24x17 mm.) of 1K, 5K and 10K, were issued in the first years of the 20th. The stamp cards mentioned above were issued for the small format stamps only, in order to facilitate accumulation of savings with small amounts of money.....DWL).

The Saving Stamps created by order of His Imperial Majesty on 26 of June, 1889, through a temporary Regulation on Postal and Telegraph Savings Offices. In the article 3 of these regulations, it is said:

"For certification of entires of funds by the savings participants, there can be created by the Minister of the Interior, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finances, the savings stamps, with the differentiation of them into categories by their values. Description of samples (specimen) of the savings stamps is to be presented to the Governing Senate for eventual publication for information of the general public."

The savings stamps are produced in St. Petersbourg by the Office of Preparation of State Documents. The length of each stamp is 50 mm. and the width is 27 mm. The paper for the stamps is white, with watermarks—for the 100 rubles stamp...clear rhomboids, the long diagonal of which is parallel to the width of the stamps. For the rest of the stamps—the watermarks are parallelograms, the long axis of which is also parallel to the width of the stamps. Perforation teeth—13.

The description of the first savings stamps of 25 and 50K and of 1, 2 and 3R was presented by the Minister of the Interior to the Governing Senate on 1 November, 1889, and it was published in the series of Assembled Introduction of Laws and Decrees on the 17th of the same November. As seen in Figures 1 and 2, all surface of the savings stamps is covered with the curly-patterned net + so that no free of printing space exists.

+ (Mr. Levandowsky informs me that the exact meaning of the Russian word used here. His translation is descriptive of the design, while the actual word is derived from French and means checkered or machine-turned decoration—KT)

Then on the 15th of February, 1895, the Minister of the Interior presented to the Governing Senate the description of the savings stamps of new values of 10 and 25 rubles, which was published in the Assembled Introduction of Government Laws and Decrees on the 24th of March, 1895. Figure 3.

Finally, the stamps of the highest denominations appeared in the year of 1896. Description of them was presented to the Governing Senate on the 7th of August, 1896, and published in the Assembly of Laws and Decrees, No. 107, on the 6th of September 1896. Figure 4.

The savings stamps are in no case given from the Savings Offices of the Post and Telegraph Offices into the hands of the depositors but they are glued into the booklets, which are given to the depositors, and are canceled not only by a canceler, bearing the name of the Postal-Telegraph Office, but also by writing on the lower part of the stamp, on the dotted line, of the date, month and year of cancellation. For receiving the stamps from the Office of Preparation of State Documents, there was created at the Central Administrative Office of Posts and Telegraphs a position of the Senior Assistant of the Expeditor with a salary of 1,500 rubles (yearly..DWL). In addition, 1,000 rubles is dispersed yearly for the increase in salary of persons in charge of receipt and distributions of stamps. Also (dispersed is....DWL) 1,500 rubles for the increase of the Central Administrative Office of the Posts and Telegraphs and 30 rubles to each Gouverniria (province...DWL) for wrapping and sealing materials etc. All these expenditures are taken from the net profit derived from the deposits received in the Postal-Telegraph Offices.

(Ed. note: The gem described below was submitted by member Abdul M. Mollah, of Bombay)



Pictured here is a strip of 3 of the current 25 Paise revenue with red overprint, mangled by a sheet foldover. The left stamp is normal, the center one has only a partial overprint, and the right stamp has no overprint at all. The overprint for the right-hand stamp appears in the selvedge on the rear, at a most peculiar angle. What happened to the remainder of the center overprint is open to suggestion.



THE DANISH-U.S. VIRGIN ISLAND REVENUES

by L. J. Baird, ARA

This paper is presented with the two-fold purpose of providing the members with an updated listing of the subject material and to stress the need for this data to be included in (at a minimum) the Scott Specialized catalog. No attempt has been made to set pricing in many areas, as this task is left to more authoritative sources. Such pricing data is solicited, and anyone able to help is invited to write me (address: 702 Rockland Ave., Lake Bluff, Ill. 60044), as is anyone able to add further data.

The US Virgin Islands consist of St. Thomas, St. John, St. Croix, and numerous other islets in the West Indies. They were purchased from Denmark in 1917 and remained under control of the US Navy for several years until jurisdiction passed to the Department of the Interior. They ARE a part of the US, and deserve full listing, as do all US Administrated areas.

All issues have a lathework background. Frame, insignia, etc., are usually darker than the background, which is normally a single color. Most surcharged revaluations on the Danish and US Bureau of Printing and Engraving-issued revenues as well as the typeset provisionals (type D) were used to collect a cigarette tax. This is also true of the surcharged-revalued US playing card stamps used in the islands. Revalued numerals are either printed, hand-stamped or typed in black. The Bureau overprint on the US playing card stamp is in 3 lines in carmine (Virgin-Islands-4 Cts.) The handstamped revaluation on RFV2 is in black. Original denominations are not obliterated on some, covered by the surcharge on others, and on still others are crossed out by pen and ink or on a typewriter.



ON NUMBERS AND RUSSIANS

By Esbjorn Swanson, ARA (Gothenburg, Sweden)


There were two serially numbered items shown in the January 1976 issue of the *Revenuer*, one being a Swedish share (shown on page 12) and the other a Russian accounting stamp (shown on page 17). Checking my own collection I was astonished to find myself one serial number removed from each. The Swedish share shown had serial number 29, while mine is number 28! And if that wasn't coincident enough, the Russian stamp shown had serial number Z 412729, while mine is Z 412730! Bingo!

Again, on page 17, the RUZD stamp mentioned in the last paragraph: The rear printing mentioned for the 35K stamp may be found reading both upright and inverted.

Further on the Russian material..please turn to page 46 of the Februbary issue: For item No. 5, there exist the additional denominations: 2, 3, 10, 15, 20 and 50 K, the numeral I on the 1K stamp being replaced by II and III on the 2 and 3 K stamps respectively and by IIIII on the remaining denominations: twice on the 10 K stamp, thrice on the 15 K stamp, four times on the 20 K, and 10 times on the 50 K. The 1 to 3 K stamps are black on brown (or rose buff) and the 10 to 50 K stamps are black on gray. The 50 K is somewhat larger than the others, being 33 mm diameter instead of 28 mm. The serial numbers at the base of the stamps vary, that being illustrated for the 1 K. being 57 while mine is 54. On the rear is some Russian formula text printed beginning with "1902 g. Sborschik podatei" meaning "Year 1902, Tax Commissioner".

Literature in Review

G. M. Abrams, ARA

The Bale Catalogue of Palestine & Israel Postage Stamps, 1977 (8th Edition); compiled and published by Michael H. Bale, 41 High St., Ilfracombe, England EX34 9DA; \$6.95 US postpaid from Mr. Bale.

While excellently detailed for the postal specialist (even unto fly-specks), the catalog is a sad disappointment for the revenue. It has not been improved since the previous edition in the revenue section (which covers a total of 4 pages, pp 212-215). Still no listings for the Palestine Mandate. Still no improvement in the first 3 Israeli revenue listings (same comment appears.. "Many different perforations from 11x11 to 14x14 exist...."). The issues of 1948-9, 1952 and 1961 are followed by those of the Zahal issues for the Arab occupied lands. All are in oversimplified form, with no varieties (which are known) listed. Period. This half-hearted attempt includes no Agrah issues, radio stamps, etc etc. Save your money, unless you are a postal enthusiast.

When we reviewed the prior edition, we voiced hopes for improvement. It didn't happen this time. Any reader is welcome to deliver this message to Mr. Bale: Let us have an expanded revenue section in the next edition. It is overdue. ARA collectors, will assist, on request.

"COMMONWEALTH OF THE PHILIPPINES", also in red. The value has been changed to 14c (P7.00-1000), also in red.

Finally, 4 different taxpaid liquor labels are used. Figure 12 shows the labels for distilled spirits. The regular label is printed in green, is 120x30 mm., is rouletted on white silk thread paper, is ungummed, and is wmkd mult. REPUBLIC OF THE

PHILIPPINES and arms. The auxiliary label has the same statistics except for size: 157x12 mm. Regular and auxiliary labels are also issued for wines. These are printed in brown on paper with a blue background design. The design of the labels themselves are the same, with several changes in inscriptions.

Lueck also received a Silver for his selected pages of Geneva Swiss, which included a study of papers used in the production of 1885 Bourse and 1887 Bill stamps.

Meanwhile, at the Garden State Stamp and Coin Dealers' Show, Wayne, N. J., also in January, telegraph exhibits took 2 of the 3 awards for US and Possessions: Charles Reiling (again) was awarded a Bronze for his US Telegraphs, while George Kramer captured a Silver for his Telegraph & Western Union entry. (According to George, this may be a first).

As a coup de grace to the show Charles Mandell took the best-in-show for his 112 page exhibit of Israel, Palestine and the Holy Land. This is the first time a revenue exhibit has ever won a best-in-show at a New Jersey stamp exhibition.

Chapter Notes

THE 1898 REVENUE SERIES

At the January 6, 1977 meeting of the New York Chapter of the ARA, Mr. Michael Rosenberg showed the complete range of documentary and proprietary stamps issued under the Spanish-American War Revenue Act of 1898.

Interestingly and properly, Mr. Rosenberg began by displaying a copy of the Act of Congress that created a need for the stamps as well as a stamp order form. The first issues shown were the provisional overprints on postage stamps. The rare 8, 10, and 15c overprinted stamps, used by the Michigan Mutual Life Insurance Co., were on loan for this exhibit from our member, Ronald Friedlander. Another rare provisional, Captain Chapman's 1c Trans-Mississippi, was shown by Mr. Rosenberg who noted that clipped perforations at least on one side seemed to be a feature of this stamp. The familiar Battleship series was displayed in unused multiples and as used on full documents. The latter included checks, a marriage license (10c), and bills of exchange which also had foreign revenues. Mr. Rosenberg pointed to the many "imperforate between" varieties that existed on the rouletted issue and said that the difficulty experienced by Bureau inspectors in spotting the missing cuts of a roulette persuaded the Bureau to change to the hyphen-hole or slot perforation. No imperforate between varieties of the slot perforated stamps are known. In the proprietary section, Mr. Rosenberg exhibited the Dr. Kilmer provisional overprint types, the St. Louis labels, the private dies, and a selection of printed cancellations. It was most interesting and instructive to see, all at once, the richness and variety of the 1898 issues of revenue stamps.
