



### 1986 Walter Morley Award

An opportune for the Editor of *The American Revenuer* to announce the winner of the of the Walter Morley Memorial Award for the best original article to be published in this magazine in the previous year's volume (volume 40, 1986) never seemed to occur. As 1987 draws to an end our decision for last year has to be made public.

The winner is selected by the Editor and Associate Editor as being "the most significant contribution to fiscal philatelic research to be published in The American Revenuer during the calendar year." Selection is made on the basis of originality, research, interest, presentation and most importantly the article's contribution to the general body of fiscal literature.

The Walter Morley Memorial Award for the best article to appear in Volume 40 (1986) of The American Revenuer is given to two closely connected articles by the same author; they are "Lock Seals" and "A Catalogue Listing of Lock Seals" by Thomas W. Priester. They both appeared in the April 1986 issue of TAR.

These articles represent the most comprehensive written work on the subject to ever appear. The catalogue is a priced listing with values determined by an extensive census of a number of major holdings of these seals. It is felt that these articles best met our criteria for selection.

#### TAR at Chicagopex 1987

The 101st Annual Exhibition of the Chicago Philatelic Society was held November 6-8, 1987, in Rosemont, IL. This show also marked the 21st year that a literature section was part of this exhibition. Thirty four items were entered including the 1986 volume of The American Revenuer.

The Editor is proud to announce that TAR received one of only two Gold medals given to literature. Additionally, your Editor also also received the Chicagopex Literature Special Award to authors and editors in the periodical class "for lasting value to philately."

Your Editor wishes to not only thank the CPS and their literature committee but also all of the ARA members who have written articles for TAR. As authors you also share in this Gold award.

### Closing Date: January 13, 1988

#### **ARA Auction Rules**

These rules apply to the ARA acution in this issue.

- 1. Only ARA members in good standing are eligible to participate in the auction.
- 2. The Auction Manager reserves the right to reject any bids which in his judgement are unrealistic.
- 3. Bids should be in even dollar amounts only. All lots sold to the highest bidder at a slight advance over the next higher bid. A 10% buyers premium will be added to all successful bids. Bidding increments are as follows:

\$5 to \$29 by \$1 \$30 to \$68 by \$2 \$70 to \$195 by \$5

\$200 and over by 5% over next higher bid

- 4. If only one bid is received for a lot it shall be sold at the amount bid or the catalog or estimated value, whichever is lower.
- 5. Buy bids or bids under \$5 will not be accepted.
- Bids must be submitted on the bid sheet accompanying these rules or a reproduction or facsimile thereof. No bids will be entered after the closing date. In the case of tie bids the earliest postmark will be considered the winner.
- In the descriptions a hyphen between two numbers (e.g.: R214-222) indicates that these numbers (inclusive) are included. A slash (e.g.: R214/R222) means that all numbers are not included.
- 8. Lots not properly described must be returned within 10 days. Lots described as defective or as having faults cannot be returned because of such defects or faults.
- Lots sold "AS IS" have not been counted or appraised by the Auction Manager and are not returnable. Bid accordingly.
- 10. If similar lots are listed and you are interested in only one of them enter "OR" between the lot numbers.
- 11. An invoice will be sent each winning bidder and lots will be forwarded upon receipt of full payment. Payment is due within 10 days of the receipt of the lots. Postage, handling and insurance will be billed the buyer, \$1.50 minimum.
- Make all checks payable to the American Revenue Association.
- 13. The placing of any bid constitutes acceptance of the foregoing rules. Prices realized will be published as soon as possible after the sale.
- 14. A 10% commission will be deducted from the final bid price when payment is made to the seller. The ARA sales will be held without reserves. Copnsignors may bid on their own material and if the consignor buys back his own

lot he will be charged only a 10% seller's commission and for the postage and insurance costs to return the lot. Mail bids to:



This supplement updates the title document (*The American Revenuer* 1985 39:No. 4, Supplement) with material accumulated to August 1, 1987. It is presented in four sections.

Section 1 consists of items previously listed to which has been added addenda and or corrigenda published after the original in the serials literature; and a few citations containing corrections of one sort or another. In this group are two items, No. 740 and 1270 which are now available as microfiche (at the American Philatelic Research Library) and are so labeled. I can not see catalogues on microfiche as hot items, but thought you ought to know.

Section 2 contains titles of new pamphlets, catalogues, etc. which have been identified or which have appeared since the original list was prepared. Numbers followed by an asterisk are in the ARA library.

Section 3 consists of a list of catalogues which have been published in the serials literature but which do not have separate existence as pamphlets or books.

Section 4 is a country index to new materials listed in Sections 2 and 3. The catalogues in the serial literature are distinguished by an "S" in front of the list number. Items in Section 1 are indexed in the original publication.

#### Earliest Cinderella Club

Member Herman Herst, Jr. has sent a clipping from the August, 1987, issue of *Stamp World* (London). The writer (the archivist of the Cinderella Stamp Club, Pat did not indicate his name) had recently obtained an 1894 cover addressed to "The Hon. Sec., Fiscal and

Postal Exchange Club, 8 Clarendon Place, Citadel Road, Plymouth.

The writer indicated that the Fiscal Philatelic Society was founded on January 11, 1902, eight years after this cover. The Honorary Secretary's name was not given, there were no contents remaining

in the envelope which was official OHMS stationary from the Post Office.

It was pointed out that exchange clubs were not what we today would call a stamp club, but was rather a circulating exchange packet. This particular packet

Document of the Month (#4)

### 1864 California Bond Stamped with a Complete End-to-End Vertical Stripof the Imperforate 50¢ Original Process

#### by Michael Mahler, ARA

When I saw this document while viewing for a recent West Coast auc-

tion, my reaction was disbelief. Before me was a strip of only five 50¢ stamps, yet with sheet margins at either end. Readers more familiar with First Issue revenues will perhaps smile at my incredulity, but my familiarity with these stamps is confined mainly to those I have encountered on document. and this strip certainly did not fall into that category.

A quick check of Scott revealed that the strip was of course quite normal, since the 50¢ stamps were printed in sheets of 85, arranged 17 x 5. Normal, yes, but exceedingly rare, for this is the only such end-toend strip of any stamp, showing sheet margins at each end, that I can recall seeing on document. Interestingly, this one was an almost perfect fit to the page on which it is affixed. Both have been trimmed a couple of millimeters at the

in February, 1861. Some months earlier, the tax on this document, as a surety bond for the payment of money, would

have been only \$.50, but effective August 1, 1864, it had been increased to \$.50 per \$1,000 ultimately recoverable

(Mahler, 1982 a, b), and thus was correctly paid. A perforated 5¢ Express stamp paid the \$.05 tax on the jurat of Justice of the Peace C.W. Riley, and both this stamp and the strip were initialled and dated by him.

The 50¢ stamps were described in the auction catalog simply as a strip of five, with no further detail, and no other potential bidders showed any interest. Hopefully this rarity has now been raised from obscurity, for it now stands as one of the centerpieces of a specialised collection of the 50¢ Original Process.

it. Could this mean it was added as a remedy to the original document thought to be in error.


